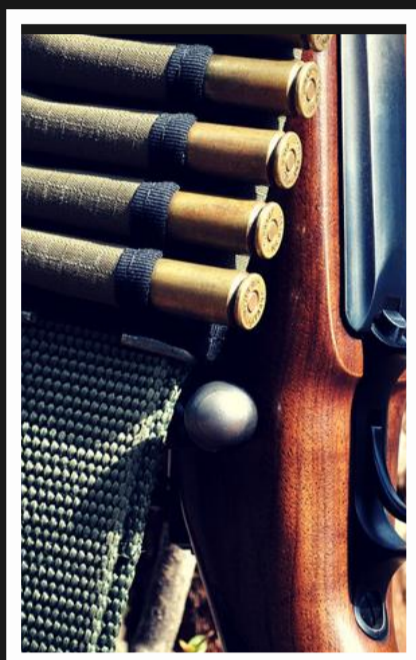


# ARH ASSESSMENTS

 The experienced team at Lowveld Trails Co. are accredited Field Guides Association of Southern Africa (FGASA) assessors that conduct Advanced Rifle Handling (ARH) & Professional Trails Guide shooting assessments.

## ABOUT THE ASSESSMENT

As per **FGASA**, Trails Guides are required to successfully complete an **ARH** assessment, and remain current, in order to conduct guided walks in a dangerous game environment. The ARH qualification is **valid for 3 years**, although we encourage Trails Guides to shoot as regularly as possible.

Each candidate will first have to attain the required **Unit Standards** through the Professional Firearm Trainers Council (**PFTC**) before an ARH assessment may take place. The three Unit Standards are;

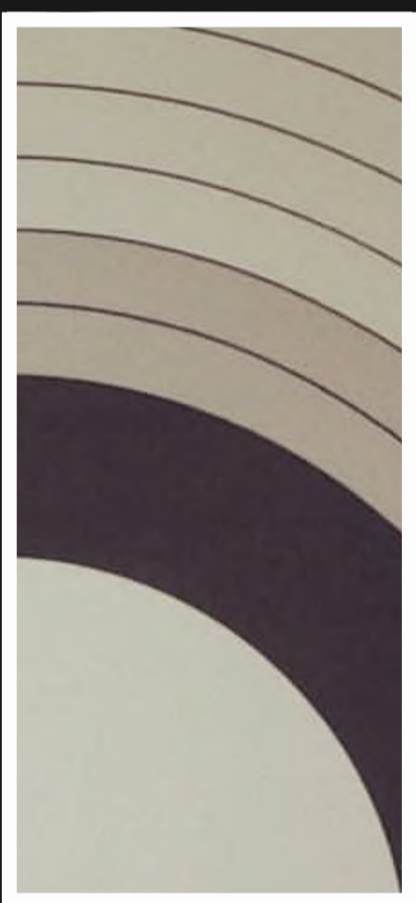
**117705** – Knowledge of the Firearms Control Act.

**119651** – Handle & use a manually operated rifle or carbine.

**123519** – Handle & use a manually operated rifle or carbine for business purposes.

Candidate will be required to have, as a minimum, the **Field Guide** (level 1) qualification and be a **paid-up member** of FGASA.

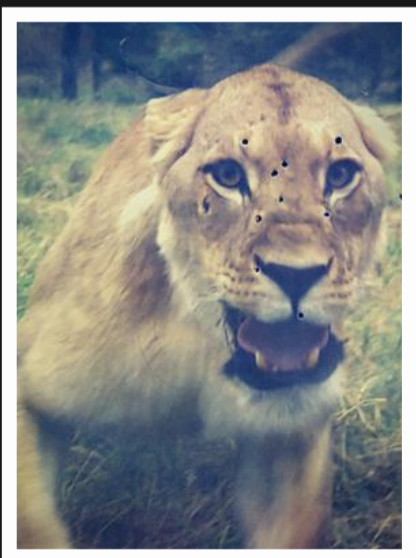
Once all of the above is in order, candidates can contact Lowveld Trails Co. to book an **assessment date**.



## RESERVATIONS

Assessments cost **ZAR 1600** per person. Practice and training costs **ZAR 800** /person/day. Rifle and ammunition rental can be arranged at an additional **ZAR 1600** /person/day. Our assessments take place at Zandspruit Shooting Range. Meeting point will be in **Hoedspruit** at 8am on booked dates; the day will conclude around lunch time.

**Equipment checklist:** Closed shoes, belt, button-up shirt (guiding uniform shirt), ear protection, hat, sunscreen, water, light snack and a copy of your PFTC Unit Standards. If you are providing your own rifle and ammunition, please be sure to bring, at least, **25 rounds** and **3 dummy rounds**. Rifle must be ready to undergo inspection on arrival so make sure that your kit is **clean**.  
*We provide ear protection should you not have your own.*
